GIVE RESIDENTS A VOICE

- Partner with the West Boulevard Neighborhood Coalition to advance residents' equitable land use and transportation goals.
- Partner with the North End Neighborhood Coalition to make two intersections and a park more pedestrian-friendly.
- Inform citizens of opportunities to express their support for policies, plans, and funding that will further smart growth, and make biking, walking, and riding transit safer and more accessible.
- Engage residents in helping shape the Charlotte Future 2040 Comprehensive Plan, which will guide Charlotte's growth over the next twenty years.

- Publish 50 informative e-newsletters, at least 70 blog posts, at least 10 email action alerts, and daily social media posts.
- Inform and inspire thousands of residents by participating in at least 60 community events and meetings.
- Research and publish a 5-year update of our Charlotte-Mecklenburg Sustainability Report Card.

ORGANIZE INSPIRING EVENTS

- Host three Shifting Gears events to identify and pursue opportunities for community collaboration in support of cycling.
- Recognize our community's sustainability leaders at the 2019 Charlotte Sustainability Awards.
- Host the fourth annual #WalkCLT in partnership with OrthoCarolina to inspire people to explore the FreeMore West neighborhoods on foot.
- Inspire more than 500 people to hop on a bike to explore Charlotte during our fifth annual Biketoberfest presented by the Charlotte Knights.
- Inform and inspire at least 1,000 residents to advocate for smart growth via six Grow Smart CLT events.

PARTNER WITH THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE

- Serve on the City's Unified Development Ordinance (UDO) Advisory Committee and recommend development rules that prioritize smart growth.
- Build support for funding and constructing the Uptown Cycle Track and completing a citywide bicycle network plan.
- Build support for completion of the projects in the 2030 Transit Corridor System Plan including new light rail lines and a fast, frequent bus network through the Envision My Ride initiative.
- Partner with the Charlotte Department of Transportation to implement the initiatives of the new Vision Zero Action Plan.
- Support a clean energy future for Charlotte by serving on the Transportation work group for the newly adopted Strategic Energy Action Plan (SEAP).
- · Coordinate demonstration projects for two citywide Open Streets 704 events.
